Showcasing the range of innovative ways that native plants can be utilized in a garden



- Best use of native plants in a garden
 - A garden is a purposefully planted area where native plants have been used to enhance and improve the look and health of a garden.
 - A garden may incorporate existing native vegetation
 - The garden will preferably contain mostly or entirely of native plants but may incorporate partly of non-native plants. *Note. Gardens with a higher proportion of native plants (vs non-native plants) will be highly regarded.*
 - Gardens with a 'natural' look are quite acceptable
1. Open to all gardens within the Sarina and surrounding districts (including Mackay to Clairview)
 2. Entries for this competition must be received by 4pm on Friday 9 August 2013.
 3. Entries to be either posted to SLCMA, PO Box 682, SARINA QLD 4737; delivered to SLCMA Office, 101 Beach Rd, Sarina or emailed to slcma@mcs.net.au
 4. Judging of the 2013 Sarina Native Garden Competition will be held in late August. Entrants will be notified prior of the exact dates.
 5. The presentation of awards for this competition will be held on Saturday 7 September, during the launch of the Sarina Community Native Gardens by Costa Georgiadis, host of Gardening Australia. This presentation will be open to entrants and the wider community to attend.
 6. All judges decisions will be final.
 7. All entrants will receive 5 free native plants, provided by SLCMA.
